Invitation to the 2nd Peer Learning Visit 28-29 November 2023, Budva (Montenegro)





Dear all,

The European Federation of Education Employers (EFEE) and the European Trade Union Committee for Education (ETUCE) are pleased to invite you to the **2nd Peer Learning Visit** of their *Schools as learning institutions – European Social Partners in Education promoting effective quality and innovation management models in the education sector in a post Covid-19 era* (LearningSchools) project. This peer learning visit (PLV) is going to take place in **Budva** (Montenegro) on **28-29 November 2023**, from 9:00 to 17:00 CET on 28 November and in the morning of 29 November.

As the 2nd peer learning visit of the LearningSchools project, this PLV in Budva will aim to further discuss common needs, challenges, and ways forward with regard to innovation management models in the education sector in a post Covid-19 era, to acquire a better understanding of current realities in this regard in Balkan countries and in Montenegro in particular, but also to look into the preliminary results from the online survey (to be launched after the PLV in Madrid). Focus group discussions can also be expected on the agenda, as a follow-up of the workshop to be held in Madrid.

Each PLV of the project will also provide participants with opportunities to learn and exchange best practices in the form of presentations, roundtables, open debates, and other interactive sessions. Discussions will be accompanied by input from selected experts, including policy-makers, education employer representatives, trade union representatives, school and student representatives, and other relevant stakeholders in education.

Accommodation and travel

Accommodation will be booked at Hotel Avala in Budva by EFEE based on the arrival and departure days which you will communicate through the registration form. However, please note that **up to 2 nights will be covered by the project**. Any additional nights will need to be covered by yourself or by your organisation. Travel costs **up to 350€ will be reimbursed** after the event for economy flights only, train travels (up to 400 kilometers) and the use of public transportation.

Venues

The first day of the PLV will be held at Hotel Avala in Budva. On the second day in the morning, participants will be invited to a school visit (also in Budva).

Languages

This seminar will be held in English. English-Montenegrin interpretation will be foreseen.

Please note that every participant will receive a rate of 40€, which can be used for additional meals during your travels and your stay in Budva.
